

Scholarship Application for school year of 2024 is due July 12, 2024.

You should order your transcripts at least two weeks before the scholarship applications are due because transcripts will generally take between 2 – 14 days to be delivered. Nearly every school allows you to order transcripts online. The best way to get those transcripts to us is electronically. **Have them sent directly from the school to**George@itharacing.com or Mena@itharacing.com

When we ask for your GPA, we need it on a 4.0 scale. If your school operates on a 5.0 scale, you simply divide your GPA by 5 and multiply by 4. Example: if your GPA is 4.3/5, your 4.0 scale GPA would be 3.44.

The calculations would be as follows:

(4.3/5) = .86 * 4 = 3.44.

We need an address to the appropriate department for your school to process the scholarship check. Please understand that if you do not provide this address, we CANNOT send a check. Additionally, if you provide the wrong address, it will delay the time it takes for the check to be processed.

If you change schools AFTER the scholarship deadline it will certainly delay the time it takes to process the scholarship and could potentially cause you to lose the scholarship, or the amount to be reduced.

Taxes – The Federal deadline for income taxes is April 15th, 2024, please provide your parents' 2023 taxes **if they claim you as a dependent**, or your 2023 taxes if you filed separately.

All documents must be turned in before the deadline or the scholarship application will be considered incomplete. If you are mailing, or having someone deliver documents on your behalf, please contact us at our office to confirm delivery.



APPLICATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applicant's parents must be Illinois residents with an Illinois state identification card or a driver's license.
- 2. Applicants must be 26 years of age or under at the time of the scholarship deadline.
- 3. The applicant or at least one of the applicant's parents must be licensed by the IRB as a Trainer, Assistant Trainer, Vet Assistant, Foreman, Groom, Exercise Person, Pony Person, or Hot Walker.

Parents of dependents or applicants must be licensed in Illinois and have worked at Hawthorne during 2023 and 2024.

- 4. Applicant must attend an accredited trade school, college, or university and designate whether it is a two-year program leading to an associate degree or a four-year program leading to a bachelor's degree.
- 5. Household income may not exceed \$100,000 per year to qualify.

Failure to submit <u>ALL</u> documents by <u>July 12, 2024,</u> will result in an incomplete application and the applicant will <u>NOT</u> be considered for the prospective scholarship.

Types of Scholarships Available

A minimum of a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale is required for all scholarships:

- Two Year Program
- Four Year Program
- Graduate Program
- Equine Veterinary Scholarship
- Trade School (Farrier, Automotive, Electrician, Plumbing, Computer Information Systems, HVAC Technician, etc.)
- Equine/Agricultural Major

Entries will be evaluated by the Scholarship Committee of the IBCF. Scholarship amounts range from \$1,000 to \$6,000 and will be awarded based on GPA, quality of work submitted, academic record, financial need, and community involvement.

Two-year students and trade-school students will be limited to three years of scholarships and Four-year students will be limited to 6 years of scholarships. All students will be capped at 6 years of scholarships.

Creative Prompts

GOOD NEWS!

This year we will not be requesting an essay. This year we are requesting you be creative with your scholarship submissions. However, here are some guidelines:

Option 1 - Create a video

The video should be a minimum of 3 minutes with a maximum of 5 minutes. The video can be about any of the following topics, or a combination of the following topics: horse racing, life on the backstretch, and/or your career goals and how they will improve the backstretch community.

Option 2 - Write and recite a poem

Essentially, the same rules as the video but this can be audio only. It could be acapella or accompanied by music. The poem or song should be a minimum of 3 minutes with a maximum of 5 minutes. The poem can be about any of the following topics, or a combination of the following topics: horse racing, life on the backstretch, and/or your career goals and how they will improve the backstretch community.

Option 3 - Artistic expression

Compile a small portfolio showcasing your best artwork. This could include drawings, paintings, or sculptures, or another form of visual art, however pictures are not allowed as they are too easy to submit. This art will be showcased at the Illinois Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association office for people to admire.

Option 4 - Interview an individual you consider to be a mentor. Via audio/video presentation, then describe the impact that person has had on your decisions and goals.
